WHEREAS, The Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey are pleased to note that Broad Street in the Borough of Hopewell, Mercer County, has earned a *Great Streets* designation in the 2012 *Great Places in New Jersey* by the American Planning Association's New Jersey Chapter; and,

WHEREAS, This prestigious accolade has been bestowed upon the Borough of Hopewell's Broad Street in recognition of its efforts in preserving the Borough's history, showcasing its unique character, and displaying a vibrancy and friendliness that welcomes visitors while protecting the small-town feel for local residents; and,

WHEREAS, Broad Street in Hopewell is also known for its myriad restaurants, antique shops, specialty services, professional establishments, and centuries-old residences, in addition to community events such as cruise nights, block parties, and outdoor concerts; and,

WHEREAS, In addition, the downtown Broad Street area of Hopewell has undergone a variety of improvement projects, such as the replacement of a bridge, installation of new sidewalks, hitching posts, landscaping, and pedestrian scale lighting, addition of accessible sidewalk ramps, street furniture, and ornamental planters, and the construction of a new Borough Hall and Courthouse; and,

WHEREAS, The strength and success of the State of New Jersey depends, in great measure, upon superb municipalities such as the Borough of Hopewell, Mercer County; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

That this Legislature hereby recognizes Broad Street in the Borough of Hopewell upon its *Great Streets* designation in the 2012 *Great Places in New Jersey* by the American Planning Association's New Jersey Chapter, and pays tribute to the outstanding efforts of its officials and citizens; and,
